## Japan Garden Tour for Pacific Horticulture Fall 2024

## **Terms & Conditions**

This information is important, please read it carefully. Submission of an online or printed Booking Form along with payment of required trip deposit indicates you have read and expressly agree to these Terms and Conditions. If there is something that you do not understand please ask us about it!

<u>Reservations and Payments -</u> A non-refundable deposit of \$800.00 per person is required at the time of booking. Written confirmation will be provided upon receipt of deposit. Balance of payment will be due upon receipt of an invoice 60 days before departure. The tour price is based on exchange rates in effect as of February 6, 2024 and are subject to adjustment on the final invoice.

<u>Number of Guests -</u> A maximum of 22 guests per tour can be accommodated. A minimum of 15 guests are required to operate the tour at the quoted price. The purchase of non-refundable services outside of tour itinerary (such as airline tickets) before a minimum number of guests have registered is at the sole risk and expense of the guest.

<u>Cancellations -</u> All cancellations must be made in writing. As noted, the trips confirmation is covered by guest's nonrefundable deposit of \$800.00 per person. Final payment is due 60 days prior to departure and is also non-refundable unless a resold reservation becomes available to replace the space of the cancelling guest. If a guest cancels in writing within the deposit stages of the booking we can refund if their reservation is resold, less the cost of the inner air segment booked by supplier and any credit card fees if paid by card. Cancellations will only be considered for a refund when the resale value has been received by Sterling Tours LTD. If registration proves insufficient to operate the tour by August 5, 2024, then we reserve the right to cancel the tour. We strongly recommend that you purchase appropriate cancellation insurance which is sold separately of Sterling Tours LTD services. We refer guests to Travel Guard for their travel insurance needs.

<u>Hotels -</u> Hotels are shown on your itinerary. Sterling Tours reserves the right to change any hotel through any circumstance---the substitute will be of equal quality.

<u>Scheduled Activities -</u> Every effort will be made to provide such services as listed, but where unavoidable circumstances necessitate changes, the best substitute alternatives will be made at the discretion of Sterling Tours LTD, the local escort, and the ground operator without financial compensation to tour members.

<u>Service Fees & Taxes -</u> Today there are frequent service charges and taxes imposed by hotels, suppliers, and governments. These fees and taxes are included to the extent possible, but where pre-payments are not allowed for entrances, or meals, the amounts concerned must be paid locally by tour members. This information will be stated in the itinerary.

<u>Travel Documents -</u> A passport valid for at least 6 months after the last date of this tour is required for this trip.

<u>Baggage -</u> Sterling is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to your baggage---again your own personal travel insurance is strongly recommended to protect against loss. Guests are responsible for airline and government-imposed baggage regulations and fees.

<u>Exclusions -</u> Your arrangements exclude international airfare, passports, visas, excess baggage charges, items of a personal nature such as laundry, communication expenses, room service, meals not specified in your itinerary, optional sightseeing and other excursions, and any items not listed in your documents.

<u>Travel and Trip Cancellation Insurance</u> We strongly recommend that you purchase Travel Insurance. We often refer clients to Travel Guard at https://www.travelguard.com/ Your travel insurance is booked separate of Sterling Tours LTD services. We do not handle travel insurance.

<u>Physical Capabilities</u> - The tour includes a SIGNIFICANT amount of walking, FREQUENT use of stairs and steeply sloped pathways on uneven or unpaved surfaces. Some of the places we will be visiting can only be seen on foot with no other access possible. Guests with limited mobility MUST consult Sterling Tours LTD prior to signing up for registration.
